Annual giving recognition is based on gifts received between January 1 and December 31 of the preceding year. Donors are thanked and recognized within the appropriate gift club on the Annual Donor Plaque in the main lobby at Plumas District Hospital. Gift clubs are named for



local mountain peaks and for the heart in the Plumas District Hospital logo. Heart of the Valley club recognizes charitable donations of \$1000 or more within the calendar year. Mt. Hough Club - \$500 to \$999; Argentine Peak Club - \$250 to \$499 and Spanish Peak Club - up to \$249.

Plumas Health Care Foundation is a non-profit organization that raises money and community awareness for Plumas District Hospital. It shares some board members with the Hospital, but it is a separate organization with a separate focus.
